Creating Displays Safety Lock Display

Description: A safety lock display is an effective way to show devices that are available to help poison proof your home. Safety locks can be purchased at department stores in the infant and children's section, discount stores, pharmacies, baby stores, and some grocery stores.

Materials:

Safety locks for cabinets, drawers and doors 36 x 24 bulletin board Colored paper

Preparation:

- 1. Cover the bulletin board with paper.
- 2. Create a heading for the board such as: "Keep Poisons Locked Up!"
- 3. Attach the locks to the board either in or out of the package. If you take them out of the package to display, label how they should be used (i.e. on a cabinet, drawer, door etc.).

Instruction:

Show audience the display as you discuss poison prevention measures.
